Use-Inspired ICT and the National Broadband Network

The power of the NBN is that it will offer all Australians access to high speed reliable communications. In many ways, this is more important than the headline data rates. Just as the building of roads and rail links supported the delivery of physical goods in the 20th Century, so too provision of high speed communications infrastructure will open up the delivery of services in the 21st Century. If all homes, buildings and offices have access to high speed reliable communications, a new service model becomes possible. Innovative new services from health, education and government, as well as many commercial areas become possible.

Guest speaker: Dr Ian Oppermann, Director, CSIRO ICT Centre



CSIRO's ICT Centre is one of the largest information and communication technologies research facilities in Australia. Areas of specialisation include: field robotics, sensor networks, adaptive systems, vision-controlled systems, health data management, biomedical imaging, user modelling, security and privacy and virtualisation.

Dr Ian Oppermann will outline how CSIRO is driving innovation and developing services which will operate on top of the National Broadband Network infrastructure. He will also speak about business and community impacts and benefits.
